Terms & Conditions

Fundraising

By taking a place in the tournament you understand that this is a fundraising event and therefore will do your best to try and raise a minimum of £50 for Look Good Feel Better to help towards funding our services for people living with cancer. Your registration fee and any funds you raise are a direct donation to the charity.

Personal health and fitness

By entering the Look Good Feel Better Netball Tournament you shall be deemed to acknowledge and understand that participation is potentially hazardous.

It is your responsibility to make sure you are medically fit and capable of participating in the event. The event organisers reserve the right, in its absolute discretion, to stop any participant from taking part if the individual is deemed unfit to participate, including mid-event removal where necessary.

Participation in the event is entirely at your own risk. By entering the event, participants acknowledge that those involved in the organisation and staging of the event shall not be liable for death, injury, loss or damage arising from participation in the event save to the extent that it is caused by their negligence.

Existing medical conditions

It is your responsibility to advise the event organisers prior to the start of the event of any pre-existing medical condition, disability, relevant medications being taken and allergies that may be relevant in the administration of any medical assistance required or in your ability to take part in the event.

In particular you are advised that you should not participate in an event if suffering any cold or flu-like systems or if you have any other existing illness or injury which might reasonably be expected to affect your performance and your ability to take part in the event.

Medical treatment while participating in an event

By entering this event, you are confirming that should you require any medical treatment during your attendance at the event, whether before, during or after the actual event, such treatment may be administered by the on-site First Aid personnel.

Participants and Spectators

Event organisers will use reasonable endeavours to ensure the safety of participants and spectators. Signage is in place to guide attendees. An ambulance and crew will also be in place for both participants and spectators.

Parents of spectating children and adults charged with the supervision of spectating children must ensure their children are supervised at all times.

Event Ejection

Event organisers have the right, in their absolute discretion, to refuse to allow you to participate in the event either at the start or to continue participation at any point during the event, should you be deemed to behave inappropriately or give cause for concern that your continued participation may cause offence or injury to yourself, any spectators or other participants. Failure to comply with any instruction from event officials will result in ejection from the event and may also result in you being reported to the police.

Use of Images

By taking part in the event you grant full and irrevocable permission to the event organiser to use any photographs or video content for charity and England Netball related marketing collateral such as website, social and print that may include your image.

Collection and use of information

Your personal information will only be used by us, event organisers for purposes in connection with this event. By entering the event you grant full and irrevocable permission for us to pass any medical details you have given us to the medical teams operating on the day of the event.
